

## Graduation Requirements

For international students, the minimum residential requirement to obtain a Master's degree is one year, and most students can satisfy all requirements for the degree within that time.

Public Finance Program	Students must complete a minimum of 36 credits and meet the following requirements: (a) Tax students must take the following courses: PFP252E, PFP501E, ECO100EB, ECO310E, ECO312E, ECO410E, and ECO411E from Category I in Table III Master's Courses 12 (Public Finance Program). (b) Customs students must take the following courses: PFP250E, PFP502E, PFP503E, PFP504E, ECO100EB, ECO310E, ECO312E, ECO410E, and ECO411E from Category I in Table III Master's Programs 12 (Public Finance Program).	Thesis writing is required. All scholars in the Public Finance program must complete two required courses of 2 credits each, namely, Workshop in Public Finance I and II.
