- This chart is aimed at students enrolled for the Ph.D. program in Public Policy.
- The field-wise course requirements for sitting in the QE are as follows:
 General Policy : 8 credits or more required in any subjects related to political theory, economic theory, or basic metric theory.
 Politics : 8 credits or more required in political theory.
 Economics and international development : 8 credits or more required in economic theory.
 Mathematical analysis : 8 credits or more required in metric theory.
 Development : 8 credits or more required in courses centering around development, economic theory, or metric theory.
 International Development : 8 credits or more required in economic theory.
- If both the English and Japanese versions of theoretical courses in the same field, i.e., which offer the same content, are attended, only one of them will be counted for credit points required for completion.
- Regarding the above lecture courses, the decision on whether that course is to be offered or not shall be decided each year, prior to the relevant semester. Classes may be added to or modified midway through the year.
