## Project aims and goals:

We aim to study issues related to a development of long-term care/old-age care because it is necessary to ensure elderly people's life quality in an aging society. In the project, we try to answer

(1) How to maintain the quality of life when long-term care is needed and prevent over-usage of public long-term care facilities?

(2) What is the role of family support on long-term care? Shall the government encourage/subsidize family support?

(3) How to provide long-term care to the elderly with a reasonable cost? What is an optimal public provision of long-term care?

(4) What are the differences in long-term care arrangement across countries?

(5) What population/labor policies are needed corresponding to the aging and long-term care issues?

## Accomplishment(s) of Project (400 words):

In FY2018, we have collected data that covers information of old people's health, consumption, and funding sources from the US, Vietnam, Taiwan, Thailand and Indonesia. We also have developed a potential theoretical model (a life cycle model) that endogenize medical/long-term care expenditures, regular consumption and savings for structural analysis. We have had a plan to look into the long-term care provision scheme, role of family support, supply of care givers, and related population/labor policy in each target country.
