# Project aims and goals:

Goal: to see how variation in behavioural factors (such as risk attitudes, attitudes to ambiguity and discount factors) can explain part of the reasons why families do not respond to climate change risks. To gather the necessary data, a survey and experiment will be conducted with approximately 170 villagers in a province (possibly Long An) of Southern Vietnam. The main SDGs relevant for the projet are Goals 1: NO POVERTY and 13: (Take urgent action to combat climate change and its impacts).

# Accomplishment (s) of Project (400 words):

In line with the goals of the project we conducted a survey and experiment in Long An province in southern Vietnam in Spring 2019. As with the previous year's project, we commissioned a local research institute (SISS) to lead the interviewing .After a week of training and piloting we conducted interviews and experiments with 200 subjects in six villages spread over 2 communes. The data has been cleaned successfully and analysed by the CI with supervision from the PI. We are finding that households have a rather complex relationship with risk, that depends on the nature of the risk, but in general richer households and the educated are more willing to tolerate risk. We are now writing up a paper that will be presented internally and externally to seminars and conferences before being submitted to an academic journal. I have incorporated some of the lessons learnt about risky attitudes into an application for kakenhi this year.
