

6-5. Research Ethics Education

In order to prevent misconduct in research activities, GRIPS provides education on research ethics as follows.

For Master's Students

- All students take an e-learning course for graduate students on research ethics (e-Learning Course on Research Ethics [eL CoRE]) conducted by the Japan Society for the Promotion of Science (JSPS) within 3 months of enrollment.
- Students enrolled in International Programs also undertake research ethics education for policy paper writing in the course Policy Paper Tutorial Writing (LAN0320E).

For Doctoral Students

- All students take an e-learning course for graduate students on research ethics (e-Learning Course on Research Ethics, eL CoRE) conducted by the Japan Society for the Promotion of Science (JSPS) before the end of the first year of enrollment (within six months if possible). This course is a requirement for taking the Basic/Written QE examination.
- Before taking the Field/Oral QE examination, students take a research ethics education (seminars, workshops, etc.) conducted by the Center for Professional Communication. This training is a requirement for taking the Field/Oral QE examination.

Additionally, all individuals engaged in research at GRIPS (including students) are required to complete some form of research ethics education at least once every three years. Please complete this training as directed by GRIPS.
