## Measures to Prevent Unlawful Acts Pertaining to Research at GRIPS

The National Graduate Institute for Policy Studies (GRIPS) has taken various measures to prevent unlawful research activities and fraudulent use of research funds in accordance with Annex 1, Annex 2, and other relevant laws. In the event that a vendor is found to be involved in unlawful dealings, GRIPS will follow Measures for the Suspension of Dealings as it is set forth in Article 3 of Annex 3.

In accordance with the above regulations, we request that all vendors that provide goods or services to GRIPS must sign and submit a Pledge stating that unlawful acts will not be undertaken. Please note that staff from the Procurement Section will attend meetings with faculty or staff who wish to purchase goods that cost 500,000 yen or more.
