Project aims and goals:

Southeast Asia is now an important global production hub of automobile industry. Previous studies focus on individual countries in Southeast Asia without adequately examining relationship across these countries in regional and global value chains. This study tries to fill in the gap by investigating how these countries enter the value chains, whether and how they upgraded their positions in the value chains, and obstacles preventing them to further upgrade. Strategies and technological capabilities of transnational corporations and local firms, knowledge spillovers between them, and external environment, namely, government policies and market conditions, and introduction of new technologies will be examined. Analysis of longitudinal quantitative data and case studies of firms will be applied.

Accomplishment(s) of Project (400 words):

The project lasts two years. In the first year, The focus is on the overall understanding of the global value chain of the automobile industry. A quantitative analysis was conducted on the overtime changes in proportion of domestic value added (DVA) and foreign value added (FVA) in the Southeast Asian countries' exports, as well as, RVCs and GVCs participation rate measured by the sum of foreign value added (backward linkage participation) in the Southeast Asian countries' exports, and contribution from Southeast Asian countries to other countries' exports (forward linkage participation). Two interviews were conducted at the headquarters of Japanese firms Nissan an Mitsubishi Motors to understand their strategies and rationales behind their decisions on investment and technological upgrading in countries in Southeast Asia. However, because of Covid 19, interviews of Japanese firms outside Tokyo, and firms in SE Asian countries will be carried out in second year (Fiscal Year 2021).
